What is the Import Controls Solution:

It is a new ecosystem which aims to digitise the import supply chain. The solution will consist of the following systems:

- **Permit Management System:** A solution for the management of import permit application, review, authorisation, and issuance.
- **IPPC HUB integration:** We are excited to announce that we are now able to not only send electronic phytosanitary certificates, but receive them as well.
- **SARS Single Window Integration:** Exciting direct G2G integration where SARS will be sending (for those clients who have opted in) the customs import declaration directly to the imports. The information sharing at this stage of the longer-term Single Window will focus on sharing of Import Declarations and Supporting Documents from SARAS to DALRRD and inspection Outcomes from DALRRD to SARS.
- **Import Inspection Management System:** This will provide the ability for clients to book import inspections with DALRRD online and for DALRRD personnel to be able to view and capture the inspections.
